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

Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) Schools

An alternative approach for offering school meals to schools in low income areas, instead of collecting individual applications for free and reduced price meals.

Benefits

- Simplified low-cost internet application process for students participating in National School Lunch Program (NSLP)
- Eliminates the need for household applications for free and reduced-price meals
- Meal service to all students at no charge
