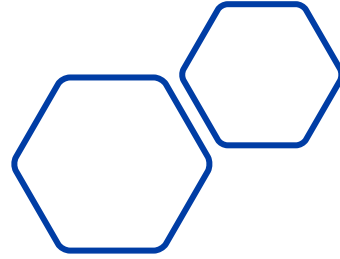

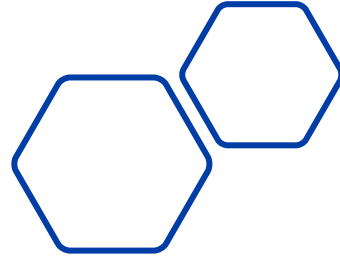

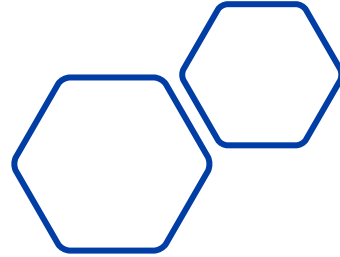

Competitive Grant Process



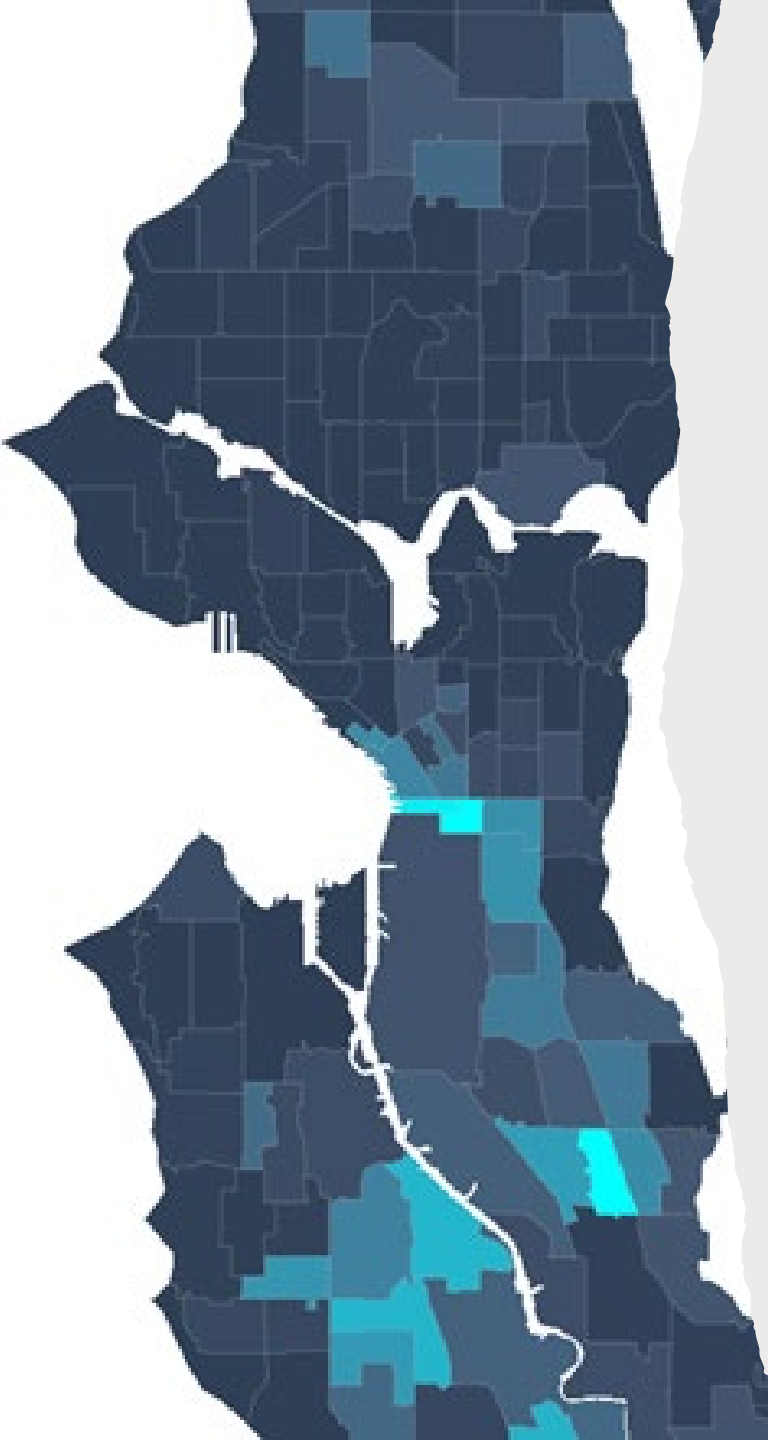
- **\$590,000** funding available

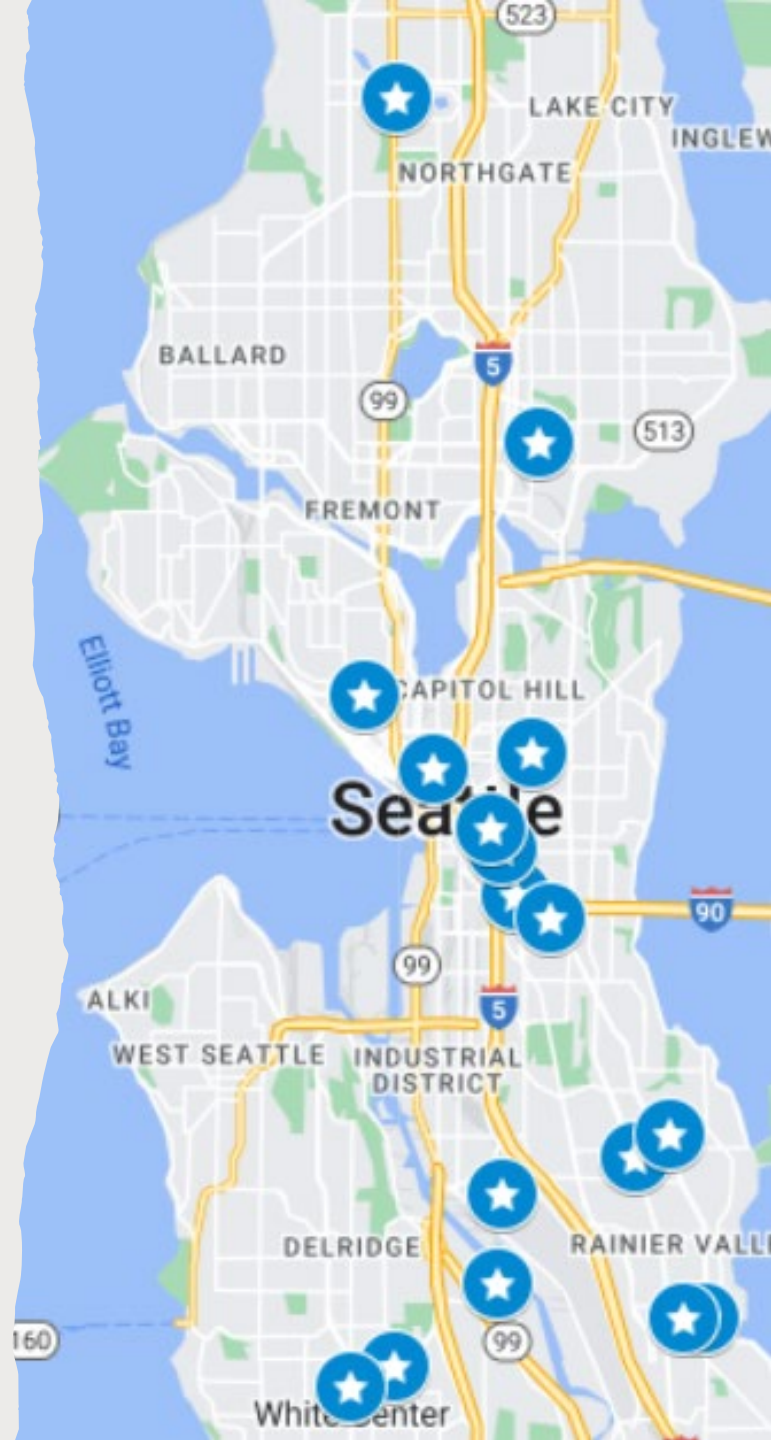

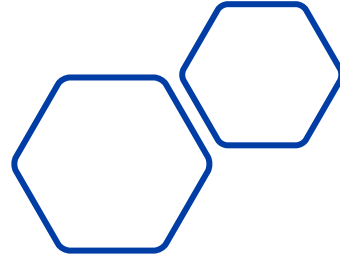

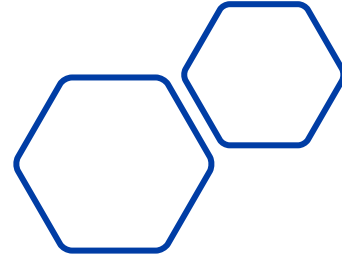
